Programme

The <u>23rd ASEF Summer University (ASEFSU23)</u> is an interdisciplinary Hackathon on "Liveable Cities for a Sustainable Future" for Asian and European young professionals & students. Implemented as a virtual programme between September and November 2021, this project connects over 90 young hackers, designers, innovators, urban planners and SDG experts from 39 countries to collaborate & develop urban solutions in three of the most populated countries in <u>ASEM</u>: Bangladesh, India & Pakistan. 3 different challenges were given to the 12 Hackathon teams:

- Bangladesh (SDG11, SDG12 & SDG13): Creating Clean Cities: Tackling Urban Waste Management.
- India (SDG3 & SDG11): Creating Healthy Cities: Tackling Obesity among Children.
- Pakistan (SDG4, SDG8 and SDG11): Creating Accessible Cities: Enhancing Urban Mobility
